- **Must be at least 23-years of age.**
- **License: Must possess a valid CDL driver's license (Class A required) with current medical card and pass a DOT drug screening.**
- **Driving: Minimum (1) year of CDL driving experience with a clean driving record for the last 5 years.**
- **Must possess (or have the ability to obtain prior to hire) Air-Brake Endorsement.**
- Must be able to read, write, and communicate effectively.
- Must be able to understand written and oral instructions.
- Must have computer skills, ability to use a tablet.
- Good interpersonal skills to establish and maintain respectful relationships with other staff
- Interpreting written information such as safety rules, sales tickets, operating instructions, and procedure manuals
